Chairman`s Report

The Olympics have sunk back into the shadows and left us with glorious memories of sporting excellence.

Despite there being a court at Versailles

(https://en.chateauversailles.fr/discover/estate/royal-tennis-court for some great photos), the French did not seize the occasion and restore Real Tennis to the pantheon of Olympic sports. Real tennis was an event contested at the <u>1908 Summer Olympics</u>, the only time the <u>Summer Olympic</u> <u>Games</u> featured the sport as a medal event. In the Official Report of the 1908 Olympic Games, the sport was referred to as "Tennis (jeu de paume)", while <u>tennis</u> is referred to as "lawn tennis". The competition venue was the <u>Queen's Club</u> in <u>West Kensington</u>, <u>London</u> and was won by Jay Gould from USA. Team GB did win Silver and Bronze, so it was a clean sweep for the Anglo-Saxon nations.....but that could have been because only 11 players from 2 nations took part (9 from UK and 2 from USA)!

Back to more mundane matters, and at our last meeting the committee agreed the subscriptions rates for next season 2024-25 as follows:




